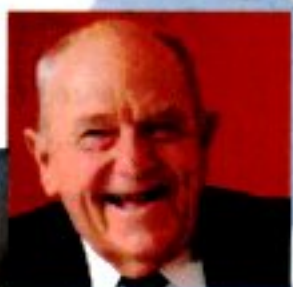

KidsAreFirst

KidsAreFirst is a program for separated or divorced parents who are experiencing difficulty communicating with each other on parenting issues

KidsAreFirst also has programs for children, aged 4–18, who are experiencing grief or anger after their parents' separation

Tenants Information and Advisory Service

TIAS is here to help renters on low income who have problems with their tenancy. People can be tenants of the SA Housing trust, housing co-ops or in private rental. TIAS can deal with all sorts of enquiries, from debt, to evictions, leases, maintenances, problems with neighbours or moving house.

Refugee resettlement

Anglicare SA resettles all new refugees to South Australia for their first six months in the country, helping them to get established, and eventually find permanent accommodation. This work is done in partnership with the Migrant Resource Centre. In 2005–06, we worked with 1455 newly arrived refugees.
