What is happening at Anglicare Whyalla?

Anglicare Whyalla, supported by the Whyalla Anglican Parish, provides daily Emergency Relief to those in need, including the provision of clothing, bedding and food. Food is sourced from the Food Bank in Adelaide, which makes provision of this service more affordable for the centre. Local suppliers are also generous with donations, including Westlands Bakers Delight who donate bread on a weekly basis. Anglicare Whyalla also conducts computer classes 3-4 days a week and provide Tax Help service for low income earners.

Anglicare Whyalla is staffed by about 28 trained volunteers, including a centre manager. If you would like further information please contact Eira Yarwood on 8644 2110.
