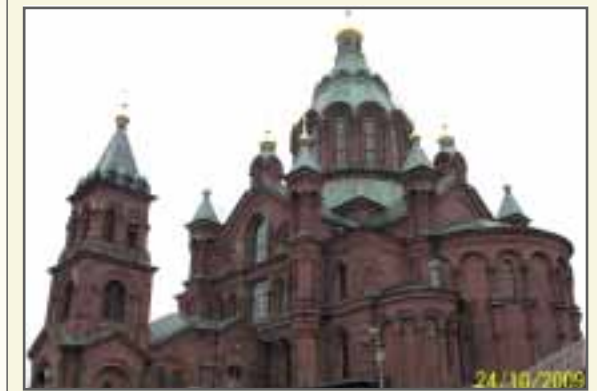
Paxton Cottages are immediately across the road from the Rectory where we will gather. Parishioners own “The Olive Grove” which has accommodation.
