Colour

- ❖ Decorate the walls with friezes of red, yellow and orange flames.

Invite the congregation to wear something red, yellow or orange today.

- ❖ Provide red, yellow and orange streamers to throw during the last hymn.
- ❖ Project images of flames like these:



Sound If you have congregational members from

different national backgrounds, ask them to read a passage of good news in their native tongue (Rather like the Save water ads on TV.)

- ❖ Present ***Pentecost Pandemonium***, a chorus play by Rina Wintour in ***Just Imagine: Creative ways of presenting Scripture***, Brisbane 2000. This play has individual voices and a chorus which allows the whole congregation to participate. Contact the Ministry Development Officer

- ❖ Play sounds of wind as people enter the church today or during the reading of the Acts narrative. Free downloads are available on the internet for those who are technologically minded. Just search for 'wind sounds'. Windows media player has visuals to accompany the sound if you have a data projector.
