If another booking is obtained following your cancellation, a \$55 Administration Fee only will be retained.

Fees will be reviewed during July each year and the reviewed rates will apply from 1st January next for the ensuing calendar year.

OTHER INFORMATION

The Visual Aid Unit (TV/DVD/VCR) is hired at an additional \$11.00 per camp

Gas heating is charged at \$4.40 per hour in Chapel and at \$8.80 per hour in the Memorial Hall.

Cleaning is the responsibility of campers (equipment and cleansers supplied)

Breakages, loss or damage are charged to the group.

Gambling, firearms and dogs are not permitted.

Alcohol is not encouraged. Permission for moderate use must be obtained at time of booking.

No tents or caravans allowed.

- Sporting equipment

ACCOMMODATION

The Bannon Wing

4 rooms with bunk beds for 6 people in each room. All rooms are carpeted, have power points and an ensuite bathroom.

The American Wing

6 rooms with bunk beds for 4 people. All rooms are carpeted and have power points. Showers and toilets are under the same roof at the end of the building.

The Jubilee Wing

8 rooms with bunk beds for six people in each room. All rooms are carpeted, have power points and an ensuite bathroom.

The Jubilee Wing also has a kitchenette and a meeting room

FACILITIES

The modern kitchen has a cold room, industrial size gas stoves and a microwave oven. All crockery, cutlery and cooking utensils are supplied

The dining room has fans and strip heaters. Tables and chairs can be arranged to suit your group.



A gas-fired barbecue allows for outdoor cooking and **a bonfire** is possible in the cooler months.

A 10 metre swimming pool is open in the summer months and there is a large area for sport and other activities. Campers need to bring their own sports equipment. A volleyball net is supplied.



The Bishop Jones Memorial Hall provides table tennis facilities, space and trestle tables



for games, art and craft and other activities.

The Chapel of Christ the King is suitable for worship and conferences. It is equipped with an OHP and a large screen, a TV with DVD and VCR, a public address system, whiteboard and lectern.
