This will be a quiet, reflective weekend in beautiful surroundings with ample opportunity to think about our relationship with God and times for prayer and meditation.

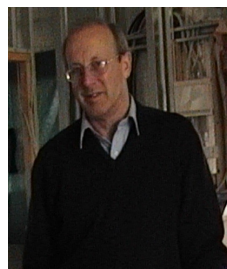
