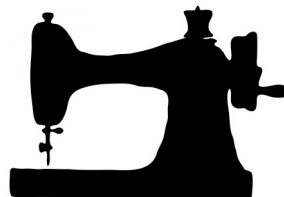

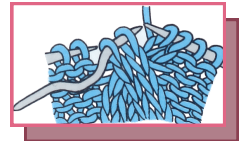

**E**mbroiderers

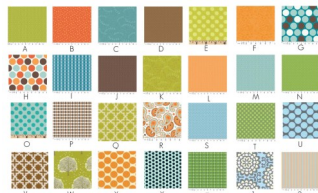
**S**ew-ers

## What is needed?

**\*Handmade** quilts, quilt covers blankets (crocheted, knitted or polar fleece) age appropriate for children and young people aged 1-17) (cot or single bed)

**\*New** Single bed quilt cover inserts

**\*Hand knitted, hand sewn or new clothing** for children aged 0-4.

**\*Decorated pillowcases** (age appropriate)

**\*Handmade carry bags** for children to place some treasured belongings.

**\*Hand made, knit, crochet, sewn (woodwork?) toys** for young children.

**\*Donations** to enable crafters to purchase supplies.
