Any Indigenous student studying in Year 11, wanting to continue their studies in Year 12, and who is from the diocesan geographic area.

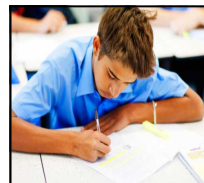
Since 2015, several students have been awarded a Willochra Bursary. Will you help us do the same this year?

Purpose

School completion rates for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students are well below the rates for non-Indigenous students. The target of halving the gap by 2020 in Year 12 attainment rates between Indigenous and non-Indigenous students is a major national challenge.

The Diocese of Willochra established the Willochra Bursary in 2015 (its centenary year) to encourage year 12 indigenous students by assisting bursary winners with the costs associated with their study.

The bursary grant may be used for stationery and equipment, books, IT supplies, uniforms, sporting goods, school excursions, school fees or other costs associated with Year 12.



Donors

The Anglicare Willochra Bursary is administered by the Diocese, and donations are tax deductible. Only part of the interest earned each year will be used for grants as the capital grows.
