CAMP WILLOCHRA, MELROSE

1. Camp Willochra is a camp and conference centre of the Synod of the Anglican Church of Australia in the Diocese of Willochra Incorporated. The mission of Camp Willochra is to provide a place for education, recreation and leisure, celebrating the wonder and glory of creation.

GOVERNANCE

- 2. The Members of Diocesan Council shall be the Board of Governance of Camp Willochra. Minutes of all proceedings of the Board of Governance shall be kept at the Diocesan Office.
- 3. The Board of Governance shall:
 - (1) Meet at least four times a year.
 - (2) be responsible for the conduct and management of Camp Willochra including the financial affairs.
 - (3) appoint a Camp Manager and other staff as and when required with the concurrence of the Bishop.
 - (4) determine the duties and salary for Camp staff, to be ratified by the Diocesan Council.
 - (5) recommend the fees to be paid for the use of Camp Willochra, to be ratified by the Diocesan Council.
 - (6) prepare a budget each year for submission to Synod, to be ratified by the Diocesan Council.

and shall report to the Synod each year.

MANAGEMENT

- 4. The Camp Manager shall:
 - (2) be accountable for the day to day running and maintenance of Camp Willochra.
 - (3) report to each meeting of the Board of Governance concerning the day to day affairs of Camp Willochra.
