Wednesday, 13 April 2022

From Midnight, as we enter Good Friday 15 April:

- **NO QR Codes** required
- **NO Density limits**
- **Physical Distancing - No Requirement in churches and public activities** - Strongly recommended where possible
- **Masks – No Requirement in churches and public activities** - Strongly recommended in crowded spaces.
NB: Individual choice should be supported for those who wish to maintain this practice.
- **Singing** – all restrictions eased, including choirs
- **Music** – all restrictions on wind instruments and bands eased
- **Movement** – all restrictions eased (movement as part of worship, multiple worship leaders, use of aisle, dramas, choirs, dancing)
- **Hospitality** – all restrictions eased as long as good infection control is in place
- **COVIDSAFE Plans** – at this stage, there still needs to be COVIDSAFE plans for
 - Prevention and support of infection control in all areas of the gathering and hospitality spaces
 - physical distancing where crowded places may be an issueThis is up to SAPOL to change or direct. SA Health awaiting this information
- **COVID Marshalls** – at this stage, there will still need to be COVID Marshalls to direct infection control and ensure community safety.
For example:
 - if people choose to wear masks that they be allowed/enabled to do so
 - physical distancing plan is in place where there is the likelihood of overcrowding
 - hospitality addresses matters of hygiene and appropriate infection control
- **Communion** – still being finalised
 - as is served now
 - individual serves observing good infection control
 - movement allowed for service - can be seated or people can come to the front
 - **PLEASE Note:** Common Cup service is still being discussed. Outcomes will be forwarded to you as soon as possible
 - If people wish to continue with single service cup, this is to be respected, as with Mask mandate
- **Baptism** – still being finalised
 - as is performed now
 - good infection control in place
 - no shared font/water
